6.4 Internet Safety Policy – Children's Internet Protection Act (Discussion Only)

<b>Overview:</b> K-12 schools that provide Internet access and receive Erate funding must meet certain federal requirements in accordance with CIPA (Children's Internet Protections Act) which was signed into law on December 21, 2000. Under CIPA, a school district must certify that it is enforcing a policy of Internet safety that includes the use of filtering or blocking technology. Therefore, the district is holding a public hearing to allow parents to voice concerns and provide input regarding the District's current filtering system.
