6.3 Education Protection Account Resolution #12-20-21

The Board will consider adopting Resolution #12-20-21 regarding the Education Protection Account (EPA) for the 2021-2022 fiscal year.

Overview: Pursuant to Article XIII, Section 36 of the California Constitution, school districts, county offices of education, and community college districts are required to determine how the money received from the Education Protection Account is spent on schools within its jurisdiction. The governing board must make the spending determination in an open session of a public meeting. The language in the constitutional amendment specifies that funds shall not be used for any administrative cost. There is also a requirement that districts must annually post on its website an accounting of how much money was received from EPA and how that money was spent.

6.5 Extended Learning Opportunities Grant Plan (ELO) - Discussion Only The Board will discuss and provide input toward the development of the District's ELO plan that must be drafted and Board approved by June 1, 2021. Overview: The grant funding requirement is to implement a learning recovery program which provides supplemental instruction to address learning loss as well as support for the social and emotional well-being of students. The Board will consider approving Jamestown School District's Summer School Stipends Overview: A four-week Summer School Boot Camp is scheduled for July 19, 2021 through August 13, 2021. A stipend of \$5,000 per credentialed summer school teacher with grade levels served in combination cohorts of incoming grades 1/2, 3/4, 5/6, 7/8 and one primary special day class. In addition, a daily rate of pay at four-hours/day for two special education aides, and four-hours/day for three weeks of ELD instruction focused on EL students at the beginning and intermediate levels of English proficiency (This may need to take place in a different timeframe during the summer to accommodate those that need both summer school and ELD).
