- Determine appropriate quantities of food supplies
- Uses, cleans, and maintains kitchen equipment
- Accurately tracks the number of meals served

est I Applicant must be able to lift 60-pound container from the ground to a 32 inch height.

est II Applicant must be able to lift a 30-pound box from the ground to a 32 inch height and repeat five times.

est III Applicant must be able to lift a 23-pound box from the ground to a 60 inch height.

Job Specific Test IV Repetitive activities to include:

Reach Overhead 20 times, Trunk Forward Flexion 20 times, Hand activities for: fine manipulation (pick up 20 paper clips), firm grasping (complete the grip test), and simple grasping (pick up a regular size pen or pencil 10 times).

The Company representative hereby acknowledges the following as valid physical requirements:

- 1. Employee lifts/carries 60 occasionally (less than 33% of the time).
- 2. Employee lifts/carries 30 frequently (34-66% of the time).
- 3. Employee lifts/carries 15 constantly (67-100% of the time).
- 4. Employee's position requires pushing a maximum force of 63.9 on objects.
- 5. Employee's position requires pulling a maximum force of 63.9 on objects.
