1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Jamestown School District's 2025-2026 Proposition 28 Arts and Music Education Program reflects a strong commitment to equity, creativity, and community voice. Based on meaningful input from staff, families, and stakeholders, the district designed a plan that expands access to quality instruction in music, visual arts, drama, and enrichment. With \$144,305 in Prop 28 funding for 25-26, the district continues to invest in two full-time credentialed teachers—one for music (grades 4-8) and one for art (TK-8) ensuring all students receive direct instruction from qualified staff. To enhance hands-on learning, the district purchased new instruments to expand the music program, implemented a drama program, provided additional art supplies for new projects particularly for middle school and provided professional development. Administrative oversight is provided by the Director of Business Services to ensure compliance and fiscal accountability. This plan supports creativity, engagement, and social-emotional growth while aligning with broader LCAP goals. Through Proposition 28, Jamestown is creating rich, inclusive arts experiences that inspire learning and student expression across all grade levels.
